General Vendor Information

- ◆ Always read the application completely, even if you have attended in past years. We want to make changes as necessary to make the festival the best it can be. Read it carefully, fill it out completely, and turn in all requested information prior to our deadline.
- ◆ Look for information on important dates
 - Spaces will be assigned after our February 1 deadline.
 - Remaining spaces will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
- ◆ Be sure to visit our website – www.camdendaffodilfestival.com – or our Facebook page for frequent updates leading up to the festival.

Non-Profit Specific Information

- ◆ The number of available non-profit spaces is limited. There is no charge for these spaces.
- ◆ Three spaces are allocated for public schools within Ouachita County.
- ◆ Three at-large spaces will be selected in a random drawing on February 1.
- ◆ If a large number of applications are received, you may not be eligible to participate two years in a row.
- ◆ All non-profits must provide your 501(C)3 number.

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The Camden Daffodil Festival celebrates our 27th anniversary in 2020. It is held on the second Friday and Saturday of each March (March 13-14, 2020). Sale hours on Friday are 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Vendor booths are to be open and staffed during the entire Festival.

There are approximately 160 spaces available for food and craft vendors. Spaces will be assigned based on applications received on or before February 1, 2020. At that time, we will place approved vendors in their locations – working from Daffodil Junction – the main downtown square. We cannot guarantee any site preference, although we will make every effort to honor vendor requests for locations.

Please enclose two current photographs representative of the work to be sold and a check or money order with the completed application form. Applications returned without photographs may not be considered. This applies equally to crafters who have exhibited at the Festival before.

Exhibitors may display and sell only the items listed in your application and approved by the vendor committee. You may not transfer, share, or add items to your exhibit space without the approval of the Daffodil Festival.

All applications will be dated upon their receipt.

If your application is accepted, then you will receive a letter from the Festival. Otherwise, your application and fee will be returned.

Booth spaces may not be sold or transferred.

Booth spaces are 12' x 12'. Cost is \$75 per booth. There is an additional \$10 charge for electricity. Once the application process is complete, you may not add electrical service.

All vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean, including cleanup and trash removal at the end of the Festival.

After initial unloading, exhibitors must park their vehicles outside the sale perimeter. All vehicles must be outside the sale perimeter before 8:30 a.m. Friday and will not be allowed to re-enter until the close of the Festival at 5 p.m. on Saturday.

A professional standard of conduct is expected at all times. This is a family event.

Failure to abide by any of the rules governing this Festival will prevent the vendors from being accepted into next year's Festival.

The event sponsor contracts with independent food vendors to provide the concession service. Therefore, craft vendors are not allowed to sell concessions. Requests for pre-packaged food items will be reviewed on an individual basis. If you cook and sell food, contact Debbie Strickland for a food vendor application (food@camdendaffodilfestival.com).

The Camden Daffodil Festival is an outdoor event, and no alternate date or site is planned. Exhibitors should, therefore, come prepared for the weather.
